### **Meetings**

The Club's first Annual General Meeting was held on 23<sup>rd</sup> January, and elections for the Executive Committee resulted in the same line-up continuing but now with half the Committee in a rolling two yearly rotation. To get the rotation right, the Chairman - Brian Sim, Treasurer - Gus Carnegie, and the Hills Coordinator – Ian Thompson, will serve for one year while the Vice-Chair – George Ritchie, Secretary - Mike Murchie and Sprint Coordinator – David Baker will serve for two years. Next AGM, the elections will be for the Chair, Treasurer and Hill Coordinator only and will be for 2 years. The first meeting of the new Committee followed the AGM.

### **Speedsport Magazine Delays**

Apologies for the late arrival of the November issue – mostly received as a Christmas present! This was due to equipment failure and malfunction at the printers – Editor Robert Smith sent it off on 7<sup>th</sup> November. We have been assured that the printers now have sorted the problems and installed another colour press and assured us that they will print within 5 days!

**Marshals** – With the formation of one Association for Scotland – SACC – coordination of the proposed list of marshals is under discussion with this body. Lesley Sheridan of EACC is encouraging clubs to produce a list of available marshals for Sprints and Hills and trying to find a consistent method of rewarding these vital individuals.
